
Great Depression Terms Word Search

A very severe recession; a period of severely declining economic activity spread across the economy (not limited to particular sectors or regions) normally visible in a decline in real GDP, real income, employment, industrial production, wholesale-retail credit and the loss of overall confidence in the economy. [DEPRESSION]

- 7. The spending and taxing policies used by the federal government to influence the economy. (2 words) [FISCALPOLICY]
- 8. The market value of all final goods and services produced within an economy during a year. (3 words) [GROSSDOMESTICPRODUCT]
