




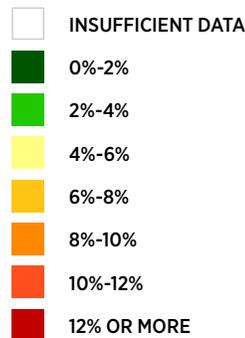

DECEMBER 2013




In December 2013, 6.21 percent of loans in Illinois were seriously delinquent (delinquent 90 days or more or in foreclosure). The national rate stood at 4.99 percent.

Change in Seriously Delinquent Mortgages by Zip Code

SEPTEMBER 2013 TO DECEMBER 2013



The share of seriously delinquent loans decreased 71 basis points (bps) in Illinois between September 2013 and December 2013. Loans that are delinquent 90 days or more decreased 25 bps; foreclosures decreased 46 bps.


